PREPOSITION BINGO INSTRUCTIONS

To the Teacher:

- A. Place each preposition on a one-inch square piece of construction paper. (Laminate for durability.) Place squares in a container.
- B. Give each student a blank "bingo" card.

Playing the game:

- A. Have students fill in each blank with their choice of prepositions. (See sample page.)
- B. Use scrap paper pieces for "corn."
- C. You will select a preposition from your envelope or box.
 - 1. Say the preposition.
 - 2. Use the preposition in a prepositional phrase.
- D. The student who gets "Bingo" first is the winner. If you are playing "Blackout," the student who covers his/her entire board first is the winner.
